Village Improvement Project: Phase I concludes successfully in Bihar

The Village Improvement Project undertaken by Divya Jyoti Jagrati Sansthan (DJJS), in collaboration with a Canadian organization, Women's Empowerment International Foundation (WEIF), is the harbinger of a bright future for the four flood-affected villages of Bihar, namely, Dhanauja, Sukhasan, Lokahi, and Parsauni. A part of the Rural Development Initiative of DJJS, this project marks the onset of a new journey for villagers, especially women who are being counselled on nurturing their skills in handling agricultural activities, with the support of Krishi Vigyan Kendra (KVK), Saharsa, Bihar.

Another instrumental plan being implemented is the training of these women to make some long term income generating products and ultimately, securing a source of revenue generation and livelihood.

From September 2014 to October 2014, following activities were conducted under the first phase of this project.

- 550 Mango saplings were distributed to 200 women beneficiaries.
- Training on organic farming was given by scientists from Krishi Vigyan Kendra.
- Awareness generation on maintaining good health and hygiene was done among villagers.
- Vitamin A tablets were distributed among children of 1-5 years of age group, while D-vorming pills were distributed to all the children of adopted villages.
 They were also familiarized with the significance of these doses, with the assistance of Dr. Vijay Kumar and Dr. Lalbahadur of Yuva Mandal Committee.

It is also noteworthy that a two-day Mushroom Cultivation Training Camp was conducted at village Barahi, Parsauni, district Saharsa, as a part of the second phase of this project. The program was attended by 40 women farmers who were trained by scientists, Dr. Sunita Paswan and Dr. Nadeem Akhtar from Krishi Vigyan Kendra, Agwanpur.

Dr. Sunita Paswan, the Scientist, shed light on the benefits of Mushroom, which helps fight many diseases. She also said, "The production of Mushroom helps in generating income for the modern unemployed youth."

This training camp will also be held in other three villages of Bihar.

Such initiatives are impactful in shaping the attitude and worth of women living in those villages. Grabbing the brilliant opportunity to boost their skills, these women have ensured their contribution in making their families self sustainable.

बिहार के चार गाँव – धनौजा, सुखासन, लोकही एवं परसौनी में डी. जे. जे. एस एवं विमेन्स एम्पावरमेंट इंटरनेशनल फाउंडेशन (विफ) द्वारा चलाई जा रही ग्राम सुधार परियोजना (विलेज इम्प्रूवमेंट प्रोजेक्ट) के अंतर्गत 200 महिलाओं को आम के पौधे बांटे गए। उन्हें कृषि विज्ञान केन्द्र, सहरसा के वैज्ञानिको द्वारा कृषि सम्बंधित जानकारी दी गई।

इस परियोजना में अगला कदम था उन चार गाँवो में हेल्थ कैम्प्स लगाना जिनका कार्य भार युवा मंडल कमेटी के डॉ. विजय कुमार और डॉ. लालबहादुर की सहायता से संभाला गया। इसी के साथ बिहार में ग्राम सुधार परियोजना का पहला चरण समाप्त हुआ।

परियोजना के दूसरे चरण में 40 महिलाओं को मशरुम कल्टीवेशन की ट्रेनिंग भी दी गई। ग्राम परसौनी से हुई शुरुआत के बाद यह ट्रेनिंग बाकी के तीन गाँवों में भी आयोजित की जाएगी।

Training Program at RIVER: Preparing Teachers for Shaping Students' Future

Teachers at Manthan-SVKs utilize a perfect blend of traditional and contemporary learning techniques. Their endless quest to learn more and more brought to them a six-day certified training program at RIVER - Rishi Valley Institute for Educational Resources, Rural Education Centre, Madanpalle, Andhra Pradesh from November 5 - 10, 2014. Attended by 17 Manthan teachers from three states of India- Delhi, Bihar and Punjab, the training program was sponsored by Women's Empowerment International Foundation (WEIF) under the Community Initiative Program of Alberta, Canada.

The training was on a pedagogy based on MGML- 'Multi Grade Multi Level' methodology to cater different levels and grades. Topics included sessions on comprehensive support program in MGML, content development and localisation, potential of MGML for inclusion, simulations on identifying learning levels and routine establishment, language, mathematics, ESL and EVS transaction in MGML classroom, RTE conformance with MGML, identifying existing challenges faced by teachers in schools and strategic planning to overcome them.
